

## Office Memorandum issued by Karnataka Biodiversity Board Proforma for payment of ABS on ex-factory sale of the products

#### Office Memorandum

Preamble – In exercise of powers conferred by Section 64, read with sub-section (1) of Section 18 and sub-section (4) of Section 21 of the Biological Diversity Act, 2002 and in pursuance of Nagoya Protocol on access to genetic resources and the fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising from their utilization to the Convention on Biological Diversity dated 29th October, 2010, the National Biodiversity Authority issued regulations on 21st November 2014 called "Guidelines on Access to Biological Resources and Associated Knowledge and Benefits Sharing Regulations, 2014". These guidelines provide for certain percentages of benefit sharing due from different categories of users of biological resources. The Karnataka Biodiversity Board, after the 26th Board meeting had prescribed different percentages for plant species that are commercially used based on their threat status for paying the Access and Benefit Sharing (ABS) in-line with the regulation (3) of the guidelines dated 21st Nov 2014.

The "Guidelines on Access to Biological Resources and Associated Knowledge and Benefits Sharing Regulations, 2014" provides two options for calculating the ABS obligation. The Form-A prescribed by the guidelines is more suitable for the applicant/trader/manufacturer choosing to pay over the purchase price of the biological resources and since there is no prescribed format for paying the ABS obligation based on the annual gross ex-factory sale of products (as per ABS Regulation 4), the Karnataka Biodiversity Board in its 30th meeting resolved to issue a format for applicant/trader/manufacturers choosing to pay over the annual gross ex-factory sale of the products.

Under the circumstances explained above, the Karnataka Biodiversity Board hereby prescribes the format appended with this Office Memorandum for the applicant/trader/manufacturers to pay ABS over the annual gross ex-factory sale of the products, inline with the Regulation (4) of the ABS Guidelines issued on 21st November 2014 in the Gazette of India
